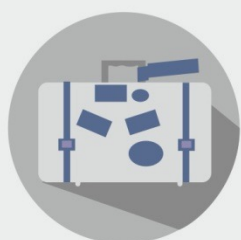

Supporting the Establishment and Operation of New SMEs in the Tourism Sector

The enterprise SACHPATZIDOU VASILIKI & LP Co based in REGION OF CENTRAL MACEDONIA ESPA 2014-2020 region, has joined the Action "Supporting the Establishment and Operation of New SMEs in the tourism sector" with a total budget of **689 million €** (500,6 million € from ΕΠΑνΕΚ and 188,4 million € from Regional Operational Programmes). The Action aims at supporting tourism entrepreneurship by establishing new very small, small and medium - sized enterprises in the tourism sector.

The investment's total budget is 76.693,32 € out of which 38.346,66 € is public expenditure. The Action is co-financed by Greece and the European Union - European Regional Development Fund.

The approved subsidised Business Plan includes expenditures on the following categories:

- ✓ Buildings and other facilities
- ✓ Machinery, installations and environmental protection equipment along with energy and water saving equipment.
- ✓ Certification of quality assurance systems and environmental management
- ✓ Promotion
- ✓ Technical engineering studies and tax and legal advisory services
- ✓ Preparation and monitoring the implementation of the Investment Plan
